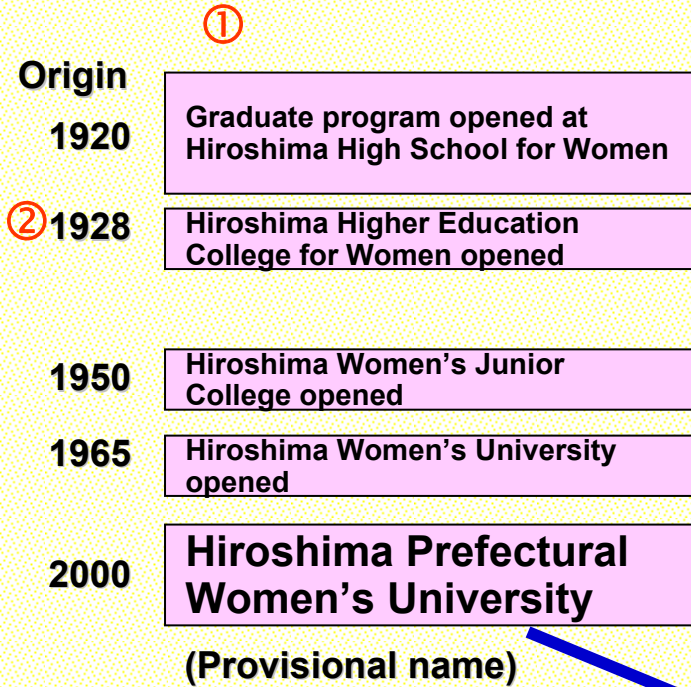

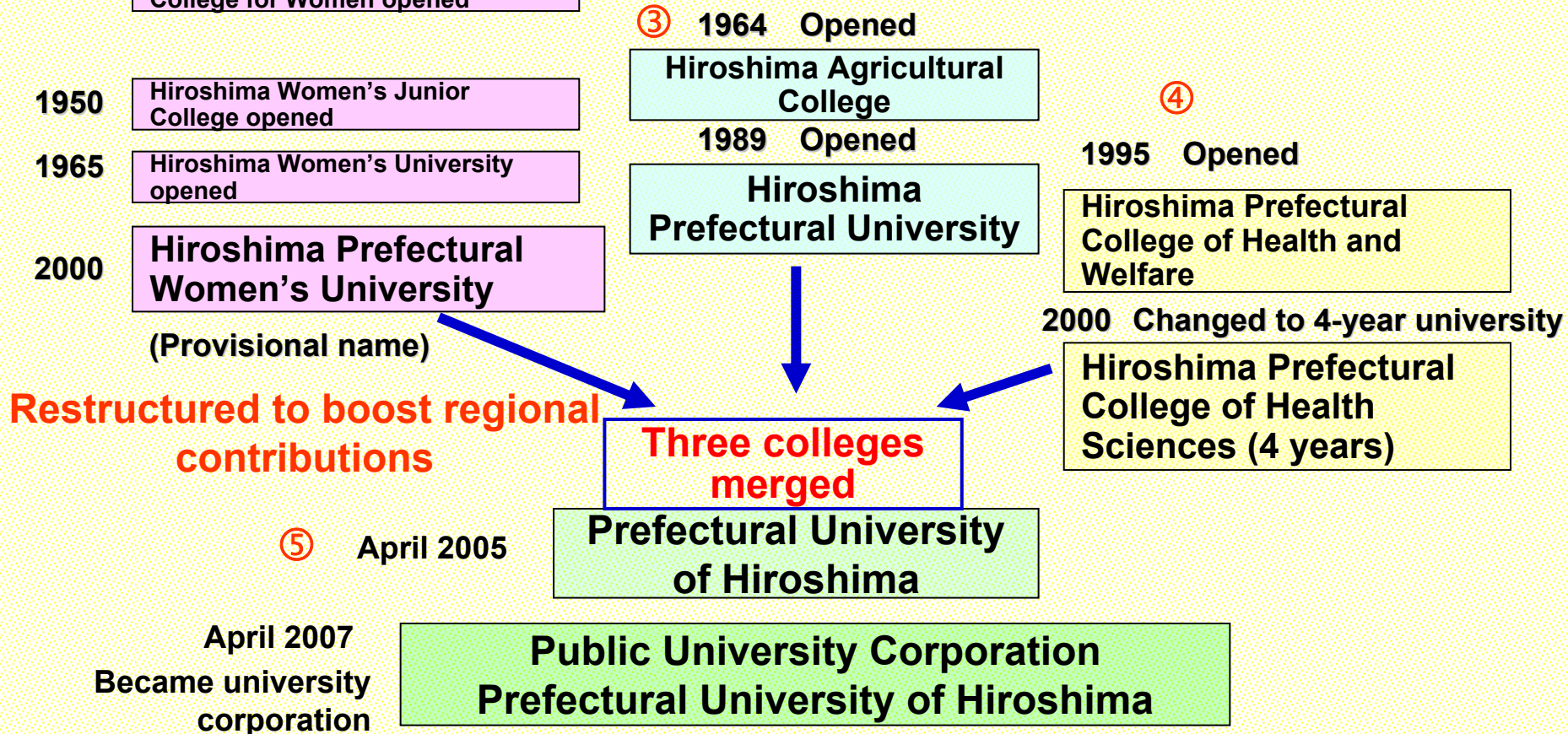

1) Prefectural University of Hiroshima originates from three sources. The oldest is ①, which became ② (**Hiroshima Higher Education College for Women**), and accepted excellent students from Korea and Taiwan. It carved out a proud history. Then ③ drew nationwide attention, and ④ was established with a high quality of education. These three currents came together to form the Prefectural University, which was made into a public university corporation in 2007.



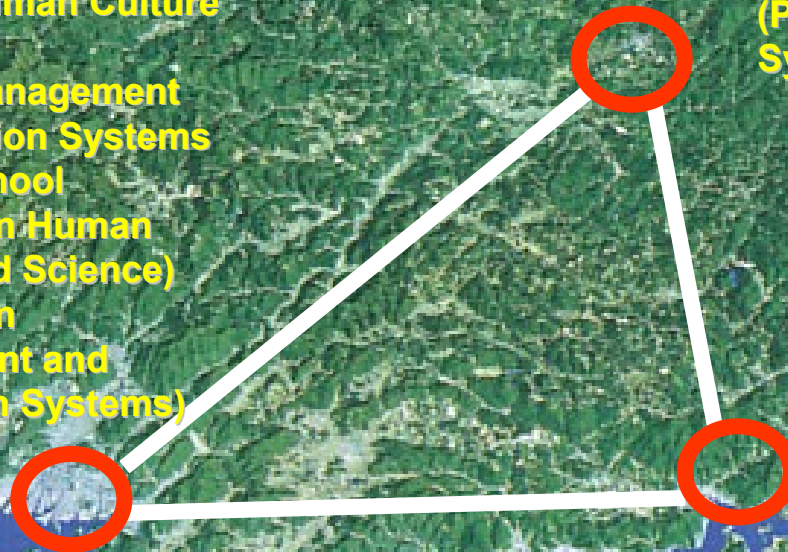
